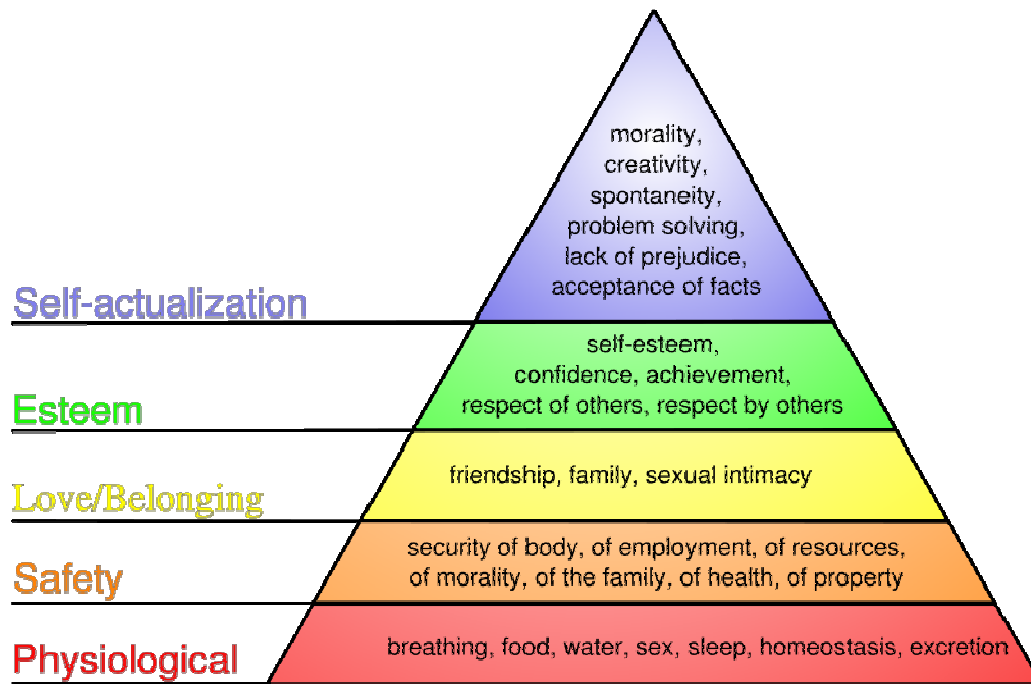

<b>UUA Social Justice Actions</b>
Service: to meet the needs of persons in distress
Education: to educate people about the importance of a social issue
Witness: to make public by word or deed the convictions of an individual or organization regarding a particular issue
Advocacy: to work through the legislative process to impact public policy
Community Organizing: to participate in the process by which decisions are made in places of power
These are complementary actions needed to transform our world and to help us come into right relationship with others. Each requires shared reflection upon our actions in order to transform our relationship to others. <sup>1</sup>
